

2018 Stenner Collegiate Cycling Scholarship Application

Program: The John Stenner Collegiate Cycling Scholarship is a program of the USA Cycling Foundation. Scholarships are awarded to full-time students who have gone the extra mile to succeed in the areas of academics and community involvement with an emphasis on collegiate team development, and competitive cycling results. Two scholarships will be awarded in 2018 to the top male and female qualifying applicants in an amount no less than \$1,500 each.

Background: 1992 Olympian and former U.S. National Team member John Stenner, one of the founding fathers of Collegiate Cycling, spent his lifetime as a bicycle innovator and strove to elevate the quality of competition of the sport he loved.

Stenner, 29, died when he was struck by a pick-up truck while traveling home from work in May, 1994, near Mead, Colo. Following his death, donations to the family poured in, and the scholarship fund in his name was established, and the original donations have since been converted into an endowment. The John Stenner Collegiate Cycling Scholarship awards continue to be funded by the annual donations to the USA Cycling Foundation.

Stenner sought the best in everything he did on or off the bike. The Stenner Collegiate Cycling Scholarship program recognizes athletes like John who strive for perfection and excellence throughout their lifetimes and in everything they set out to achieve.

Eligibility: Applicants must be a full-time student, as determined by the institution, for the academic year 2018. The applicant must also be a **U.S. Citizen, a member of a current USA Cycling Collegiate cycling club and hold a current USA Cycling Collegiate racing license.**

How to Apply: Complete the following application and mail or fax to the address listed below with all supporting documents. **All applications must be received by Friday, April 20, 2018.** The scholarship recipients will be announced at the Collegiate Road National Championships on Saturday, May 5, 2018.
